

## CHAPTER 1

**GENERAL TRAFFIC PROVISIONS**

## SECTION:

- 5-1-1: Off Highway Use  
5-1-2: Street Access Restricted; School Zone  
5-1-3: Stop Sign On Pine Street

5-1-1: **OFF HIGHWAY USE:**

- A. Off Highway Use Prohibited: It shall be unlawful for any person to use or operate a "motor vehicle", as defined by Idaho Code section 49-123, on any public property or property owned by the city other than streets, alleys, and parking areas which are designated for motor vehicle use. (Ord. 158, 6-9-1981; amd. 2010 Code)
- B. Vehicle Owner Liable For Damage: Every owner of a motor vehicle shall be responsible for any damage to public property or property owned by the city caused by himself or any person using a motor vehicle on public property or property owned by the city which is not designated for motor vehicle use. (Ord. 158, 6-9-1981)
- C. Violation; Penalty: Any person convicted of a violation of this section shall be subject to penalty as provided in section 1-4-1 of this code. (Ord. 158, 6-9-1981; amd. 2010 Code)

5-1-2: **STREET ACCESS RESTRICTED; SCHOOL ZONE:**

- A. Restricted: Traffic on the south two hundred sixteen and one-half feet (216 $\frac{1}{2}$ ') of Elm Street between the playground and the elementary school is hereby restricted between the hours of seven thirty o'clock (7:30) A.M. and four thirty o'clock (4:30) P.M. on school days. The Potlatch school district is hereby authorized to place signs and barricades on Elm Street giving the public notice that the street access is restricted. School district and emergency vehicles shall be

authorized to utilize Elm Street at all times, all other vehicles are prohibited from using the street during the aforementioned hours. Entering Elm Street when signs prohibit entrance shall be a violation of this section.

- B. Penalty: Violation of this section shall be a traffic infraction punishable as provided in section 1-4-1 of this code. (Ord. 406, 3-9-1998; amd. 2010 Code)

5-1-3:           **STOP SIGN ON PINE STREET:**

- A. Designated Stop Street: All motor vehicle traffic traveling north on Pine Street in the city shall come to a complete stop at the south intersection of said Pine Street and Fourth Street before entering the intersection of Pine Street and Fourth Street.
- B. Erection Of Stop Signs: The city maintenance foreman and employees are hereby authorized and directed to place a stop sign, in accordance with the laws of the state of Idaho, on Pine Street at the intersection of Pine Street and Fourth Street directing northbound motor vehicle traffic to stop at said intersection as provided in subsection A of this section.
- C. Violation; Penalty: Any operator of a motor vehicle that shall fail to comply with or violate any of the provisions of this section shall be subject to the provisions of Idaho Code title 49. (Ord. 141, 6-12-1979)
