

Can you believe it is the end of September, the first of October already? Feeling that chill in the air? That also means youth hunting season begins for rooster pheasants in Idaho! It's time to make plans for where you will be hunting Upland Game Birds – starting October 1! REMEMBER, IF YOU ARE GOING TO HUNT ON PRIVATE LAND, YOU WILL NEED PERMISSION TO HUNT OR YOU WILL BE CONSIDERED TRESPASSING!

The Palouse River Upland Game Youth Area / Access Yes! Area between Potlatch and the Washington State line on the Gottschalk farm on the Palouse River will be open the first week FOR YOUTH ONLY HUNTING for pheasants. This hunting area is for youth ages 17 and under who have completed their hunter education and have their hunting license or a passport. NOTE: YOUTH MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A LICENSED HUNTER.


IDFG and The Gamebird Foundation will be releasing Rooster Pheasants for the youth to hunt on Saturday, Oct. 4 at 7:30 a.m. Hunting start time is at 8 a.m. All are welcome to come out and help release pheasants at 7:30 a.m. every Saturday morning from Oct. 4 through Thanksgiving weekend. This is a really exciting experience for young and old alike. You can get Hunting and Access Yes! brochures at local hunting licensing businesses. Or just enjoy viewing the more than 8K pheasants and Red-Legged Partridges (cousins

to the Chukars) that we raised and released this last year.

Directions to the Palouse River Upland Game Youth Area: From Potlatch, go west on Hwy 6, continue south on Hwy 6/Hwy 95 until Hwy 6 turns west towards Palouse, WA. Travel along Hwy 6 for about 2.5 miles and turn left onto Wellesley Rd. Travel along Wellesley Rd. for 1.75 miles and turn left onto South River Rd. The access point is on the left just after you cross the bridge. Look for the Access YES! Kiosk. **NOTE:** The Palouse River Upland Game Hunting season is from October 1 – December 31, 2025. Access is for six youth with a mentor per day.

Supplemental Levy Update. On election day last May, a \$1,700,000 supplemental levy was approved. We shared that the estimated cost of levy would be \$354.88 per \$100,000 value of a home. That estimated cost did not include any property tax relief the district would receive from the state.

In the 2024-‘25 school year, the district received \$242,769.00. which reduced the cost of the levy to \$1,457,231.00.

This school year we just received \$396,352 which reduces the cost of the 2025-‘26 levy to \$1,303,648.

What does this mean for you as an individual? You should see a decrease in what you pay for property taxes for the district.

In August, I was hopeful that our Ag Shop remodel project would be completed before the first day of school. Well, I was slightly off that mark. However, we are getting close. We do plan to hold a ribbon-cutting ceremony and tours, but are shooting for later in October. We do know that Mr. Sawyer and his students will begin using the new classroom space soon.




