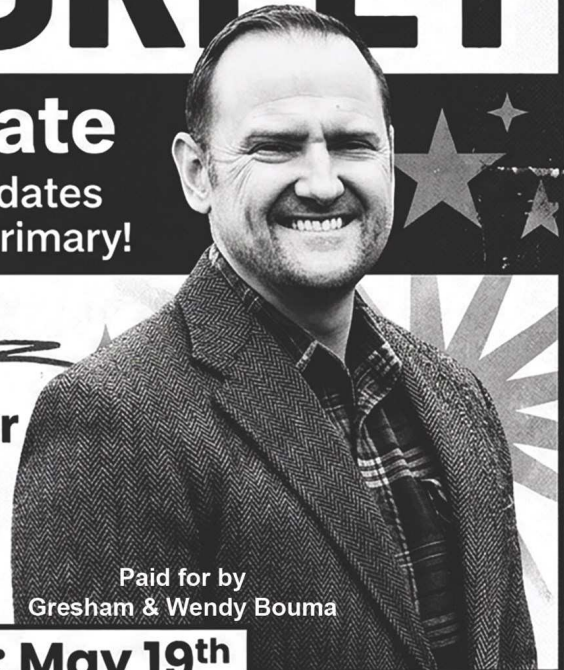

## Our Schools

Idaho Spring weather is here, and, as always, if you don't like the current weather, just wait 15 minutes, and it will change! High school baseball, softball, and track athletes are already in competition mode. Our spring sports schedules can be impacted daily by the weather. Be sure to watch our Potlatch School District Facebook page for those changes.

Spring is also the time to begin planning the school budget for the '26-'27 school year. Last year's legislative session ended with increases in salaries and benefits and medical insurance, but no increase in operational funding (what the legislature calls "discretionary"). This year's legislative session is coming to a close, and it looks like we will not be getting any increases in operational funding or salaries and benefits, a decrease in transportation funding, and a slight increase in medical insurance. I have spent time in Boise (both in person and virtually) speaking with legislators about how their decisions impact our students and community.

Our Board met a couple of times to discuss budgetary needs for next year. On March 11, the Board passed a resolution to *lower* our supplemental levy to \$1,650,000 for the '26-'27 school year. In addition, we plan to use approximately \$380,000 from our fund balance to ensure a balanced budget. You will have a chance to vote on the levy during the primary

on May 19. This is the only opportunity the district has to run a levy for the '26-'27 school year.

The estimated cost of the \$1,650,000 levy is \$336.67 per \$100,000 and is for one year; however, this does not include property tax relief approved by the Legislature. The levy will support the following programs and staffing:

Career Technical Education programs that include Family and Consumer Science (known as Home Ec. when I was in school □), Photography, Business Education, and Ag Education (classes like welding, wood shop, forestry, animal science, and small engines, just to name a few).

Enrichment/Elective programs like Art/STEAM and Music.

Special Education staffing and student services.

Extracurricular Athletics and Activities

General Maintenance and Custodial Staffing and Supplies

In-person voting will take place from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. on **Tuesday, May 19**, at your regular polling location. Early voting will be available at the Latah County Courthouse from April 27 through May 15. Absentee ballots must be requested by May 8

and returned to Latah County by May 19. See [VoteIdaho.gov](http://VoteIdaho.gov) for more information on where you vote, how to register to vote, or how to request an absentee ballot.

Spring planning means it is time for Kindergarten Round-Up! Do you have a child, grandchild, niece, nephew, or neighbor who will be five years old before school starts next year? We want to meet them on April 17, 2026! Pre-school screening is scheduled for the same day. Contact the elementary school at 208-875-1331 to schedule an appointment. If you have a child who will be entering first grade but didn't attend kindergarten in Potlatch, we would love to hear from you as well!

The April Coffee with the Superintendent is scheduled for Wednesday, April 8 at 9 a.m. at the Savory Bee. Board member Mike Gilmore will be there with me and is excited to chat with you. I encourage you to come and join us there.
