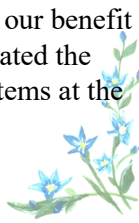

## F.M.B.E. 4-H News

This month, I would like to highlight the Horse and Non-Horse 4-H projects. The F.M.B.E. and Jr. Farmers 4-H clubs are teaming up to bring the Potlatch area this opportunity for 4-H members.

The horse project has been growing over the last few years. Members can participate in the Model Horse Show in February, the Horse (knowledge) Bowl at the University of Idaho Activities Day in April, the Horse Judging Contest on May 2, and the Horse Show on Aug. 8 at Cayuse Kids Horse Arena in Princeton.

Horse members have been having project meetings at the library to learn all about the equine disciplines of riding, showing, judging, and caring for their horse(s). They will begin to meet next month with their animals to practice hands-on training.

Because the horse members don't show or compete at the Latah County Fair, they often take on other projects. However, horse members can qualify for district, state, and national competitions in Horse Judging and Horse Bowl.

The deadline for signing up for Shooting Sports is the end of April.

Beef weigh-in was completed on April 18 at the University of Idaho. Our club has three members taking a steer project: Dean, Clara, and Denton. They have 150 days to get their steers finished. Their steers weighed 818, 982, and 945 pounds, respectively. They need to weigh 1,100 pounds by the fair. Good luck!

Most of our 4-H members taking a market swine project have already bought their weaner pigs. Weigh-in for swine is a two-day event. 4-Hers in the Potlatch area are scheduled to have a weigh-in on May 27 at the fairgrounds.

## Our Schools

I want to start this month's article by thanking our community's first responders. Potlatch Fire and Ambulance, Latah County Sheriff, Idaho State Police, Moscow Paramedics, and the Life Flight Network put on a DUI assembly for our Jr/Sr High School students. This important event helped to raise awareness among our students about the dangers and real-life consequences of impaired driving. It also served as a valuable training opportunity for our local law enforcement and medical response partners, allowing them to practice and prepare for real emergency situations. Thanks to Deputy John Paradis and Deputy Chris Gilbertson, who narrated and explained the events for students during the demonstration. Thanks again to our local Potlatch volunteers who put their lives on the line to serve those in need.

Just a reminder that election day for our Supplemental Levy is Tuesday, May 19. In-person voting will take place from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. at your regular polling location. Early voting will be available at the Latah County Fairgrounds from May 4 through May 15. Absentee ballots must be requested by May 8 and returned to Latah County by May 19. See [VoteIdaho.gov](http://VoteIdaho.gov) for more information on where you vote, how to register to vote, or how to request an absentee ballot.

The breakdown of how the Supplemental Levy money will be used is as follows:

\$467,000 for Career Technical Education and Elective/Enrichment Staffing.

Courses such as Wood Shop, Welding, Nutrition, Career Exploration, Business Management, Financial Literacy, Art, STEAM, Band, Choir, Photography, Agriculture Education, Forest Products, and Culinary Arts (Cooking).

These courses allow students to follow a career pathway and earn certifications.

\$545,000 for Special Education staffing and student services

\$468,000 for General Maintenance and Custodial staffing, supplies, and contracted repairs.

\$170,000 for Extracurricular Athletics and Activities

for a total of \$1,650,000. The estimated cost to taxpayers is \$336.67 per \$100,000 and is for 1 year. However, this does not include property tax relief approved by the Legislature.

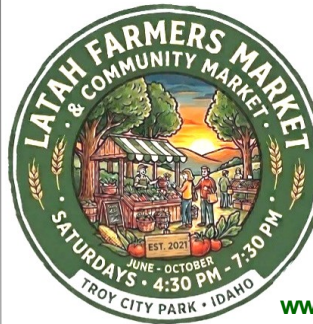
