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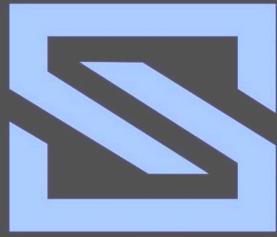

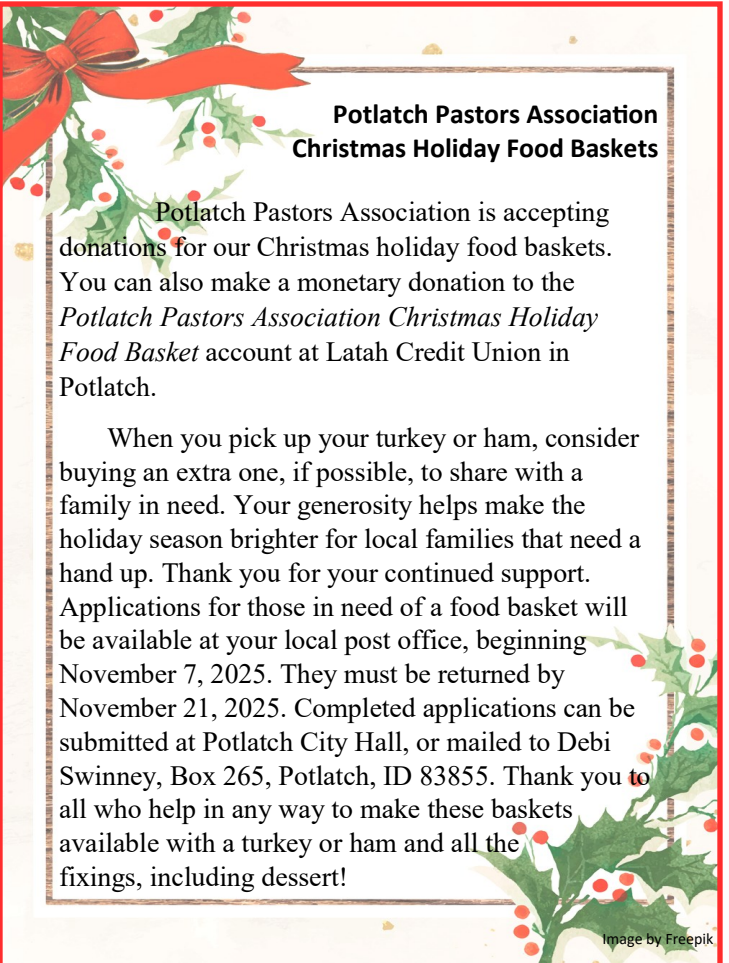

We blinked and the first quarter of the '25-'26 school year is over. Along with falling leaves, the last two weeks of October bring district volleyball, parent-teacher conferences, PTO Trunk or Treat, and possible football play-in games.

Early in October, some of our students attended the University of Idaho Forestry Days sponsored by the U of I College of Natural Resources. The focus of the event was for students in grades 6-12 to get hands-on experience in forestry, forest products in Idaho, and all the job opportunities there are “in the woods.” Students visited the UI Experimental Forest and rotated through different stations ranging from wildland fire management, fire line construction, milling logs into lumber, loading and unloading logs, planting trees, setting chokers, log scaling, and much more. Thanks to Rob Keefe, Bennett Lumber, Potlatch Deltic, Idaho Department of Lands, Pine Creek Logging, Idaho Project Learning Tree, and countless others who made this happen for our students and others in the area.

We have announced “Congratulations” a couple of



times on our Facebook and Instagram pages. However, I know that some of you don't have access to those platforms. So, congratulations once again to Karen Rohn.

Karen was named “K-12 Art Teacher of the Year” by the Idaho Art Teachers Association. She was featured in articles found in the Moscow-Pullman Daily News and Idaho Ed News. She was presented the award at the October IATA conference where a video was played in tribute. One nominator shared, “Karen is a connector in the truest sense. She actively engages our community in meaningful ways, inviting local support for our schools through donations, shared art displays, and collaborative public projects. Her ability to bring people together...is a give that continues to strengthen the bonds within our small town.”
