



Early in October, some of our students attended the University of Idaho Forestry Days sponsored by the U of I College of Natural Resources. The focus of the event was for students in grades 6-12 to get hands-on experience in forestry, forest products in Idaho, and all the job opportunities there are "in the woods." Students visited the UI Experimental Forest and rotated through different stations ranging from wildland fire management, fire line construction, milling logs into lumber, loading and unloading logs, planting trees, setting chokers, log scaling, and much more. 




