1. CONSENT AGENDA

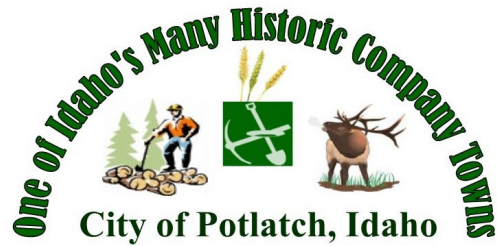

2. MAIN LINE REPAIR/REPLACEMENT - DISCUSSION

A slow leak has been discovered on HWY 6 after the main line repair. Leak is most likely at a connection and caused by recent repairs. Roach Construction will be out to evaluate and repair the line if needed the week of March 30th. Roach strongly advises that the City work to get funding to replace the entire line as further repairs could cause more leaks. Marty would like to see a quote from Roach with an estimate at how much the entire line replacement would cost and how much per 100' if we did a little at a time.



3. POOL PROJECT - DISCUSSION

The pool liner installer is booked out thru the middle of summer. The city needs to decide if they want to have a shortened pool season, no pool season, or delay the project until September. Council at this time would like to see the project delayed until after the pool season. The construction foreman will be out to view the pool on Tuesday March, 14th. Once he has a chance to evaluate the pool we will know more

4. PUMP FOR PARK

Paul got a small pump for the park but would like to get a bigger pump that can be wired in. Also a larger catch basin would be helpful. Mayor Brown said that the City and Recreation District could go in together for new pumps and also bury the drain line.
